Human Trafficking Awareness Month

January marks Human Trafficking Awareness Month, a time to deepen awareness and recommit to action. 88% of human trafficking survivors report a prior history of domestic or sexual violence, underscoring a direct pipeline between intimate partner abuse and trafficking.

At Jenesse Center, we know trafficking rarely begins with a stranger. For many survivors, exploitation starts with control, coercion, and abuse by someone they know and trust. Domestic violence creates the conditions that traffickers exploit through isolation, fear, and economic dependence.

This month, we reaffirm our commitment to survivor-centered, trauma-informed services that address violence in all its forms. From emergency shelter and legal advocacy to counseling and long-term support, our work is rooted in safety, dignity, and healing.

Los Angeles Wildfires One Year Later

One year after the January wildfires displaced thousands of families across Los Angeles County, the impact continues to unfold. In the immediate aftermath, Jenesse Center mobilized an emergency response to support families through the West Adams Leimert Park Family Source Center (FSC).

Our team provided essential resources, mental health support, and survivor-centered care during a moment of profound disruption. For survivors of domestic violence, displacement increases risk, isolation, and vulnerability. Our response centered those overlooked.

Today, our commitment remains strong. Recovery is not a moment, but a process, and Jenesse Center continues to stand with families navigating long-term healing and stability.
